2.	Prof. M. Tariq Banday has also been appointed as the Chairman of CIIE, KU.
3.	FIST 2024 proposal submitted for IOT to the tune of Rs. 3 Crore under Director, IOT.
4.	Upon his joining IOT, the new Director conducted on spot inspection of the college. He
	also met with faculty and student CR's to envisage the state of affairs, and formulate
	agendas for the road ahead. The new Director issued notice to students for punctuality
	in classes, and due diligence in their responsibilities
5.	Arrangements made under orders of Director, IOT for National Election awareness
	among students of IOT.
6.	IOT approved as research center for guiding PhD programmes. Doctoral faculty of IOT to
	supervise PhD scholars in collaboration with Dept. of Electronics & Instrumentation KU,
	and NIT Srinagar.
7.	The PhD academic calendar for 2024 issued by Directorate of Admissions.
8.	HVC visited IOT, and interacted with students of DYD Programme. Director IOT,
	Coordinators of IOT and DYD mentors were also present at the occasion.
9.	CIIE, KU organized 3 day Boot camp for innovation, design and entrepreneurship. There
	were 8 sessions attended by experts from HEIs like IIT Kanpur, IIM Jammu, NIT
	Srinagar, etc.
10.	Innovator students of CIIE, KU attended meeting with angel investors at NewGen IEDC,
	KU. The students were pitched for moving to startups.
11.	A patented project by two graduated students, and faculty of IOT, was awarded funding
	of Rs. 5 Lac by SKUAST, Srinagar. CIIE, KU filed the initial patent, and KU is co-applicant
	to the patent.
12.	Funding of two patents submitted by CIIE, KU was reimbursed to the tune of Rs. 56,000.
13.	Teaching and non-teaching faculty of IOT attended election-duty training at designated
	city centres.
