### Work Done Report

Following activities were carried out during the month of January 2025 at the Institute of Technology (IOT), University of Kashmir, Zakura Campus.

S. No	Activity
1.	Winter vacations going on at University of Kashmir and its campuses including IOT, till 23 <sup>rd</sup> February 2025.
2.	Administrative officials attending duties along with non-teaching staff at IOT.
3.	Final arrangements made for concluding billing for FY 2024~25. Coordinators have submitted necessary bills in the office of Director, IOT.
4.	PC's of various labs, offices and faculty at IOT, upgraded to latest SSD and RAM configurations by installing necessary hardware.
5.	Winter internship workshops conducted across various departments. Students from across valley participated. Live lectures, demos and hands on technical training sessions held by experts. The subjects covered state-of-the-art technologies in various engineering disciplines.
6.	KU annual PhD admissions calendar issued by Dean Research, KU. It also includes notifications for PhD admissions to IOT.
7.	The Govt. sponsored ANFR-PAIR Project has been announced with IISER, Pune as hub institution, and KU as spoke institution. Proposals have been submitted by KU by its departments and campuses. IOT has also submitted a project proposal under the same project, with financial implication of approximately Rs. 1.5 Crore. The project has investigators from IOT faculty, and revolves around Designing Novel Drug Delivery Mechanisms using Artificial Intelligence. The proposal has been completed and submitted to higher authorities. Two Co-PIs from IISER Pune have also been included in the project after seeking their consent.
8.	Dr. Bilal Malik, Coordinator CIIE KU, delivered one lecture in the one week Artificial Intelligence related refresher course held in KU.
9.	CIIE KU submitted a proposal to AICTE for conducting an Innovation & Entrepreneurship based 1 week FDP.
10.	Dept. of Civil Engineering is constructing the Cement and Concreting Lab at IOT.
11.	Interactive panels and 20 PCs purchased for Dept. of Civil Engineering and Dept. of Mechanical Engineering.
12.	Seating arrangements made for IOT sports court. 20 benches fabricated and installed.
13.	Hothouse with area of 40 x 20 sq. feet, constructed at IOT for floral potted-plants.
